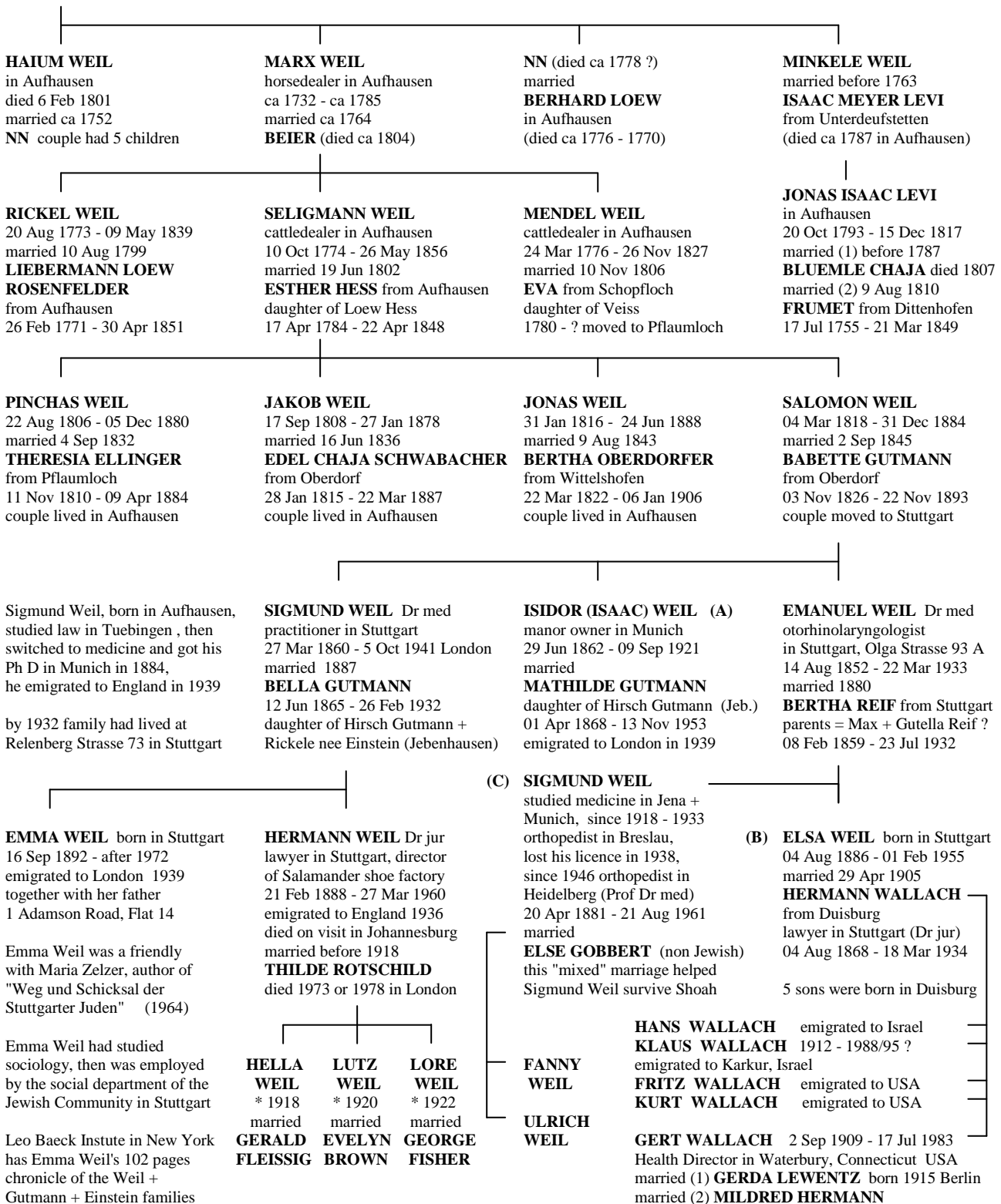


WEIL (1) FAMILY OF AUFHAUSEN

Extract of ancestral chart compiled by Rolf Hofmann (HarburgProject@aol.com) - there were two different Weil families in Aufhausen

JONAS WEIL since 1709 in Aufhausen taxlist, lived in house of cousin Hess, he died 29 Apr 1762 in Aufhausen, no widow known



(A) Isidor + Mathilde Weil produced 2 sons = Fritz Weil (who was killed as soldier in WW I) + Herbert Weil who emigrated to London (England)

(B) Else Weil posed for the "Stuttgardia Sculpture", outdoor wall decoration at Stuttgart City Hall. She became manager of the Jewish Old People's Home at Wagenburg Strasse in Stuttgart. She emigrated to England in the 1930s and died when visiting her brother Sigmund in Heidelberg. She was buried at the Jewish section of Prag Cemetery in Stuttgart.

(C) In 1923 Sigmund Weil became the leader of the orthopedic department at Breslau Surgical University Hospital - in 1933 he was forced to leave this hospital because of his Jewish origin. In 1946 he was appointed leader of the Orthopedic Hospital of Heidelberg University and stayed in this position until 1954, estimated because of his professional reputation. Today there is a Sigmund-Weil-Klinik in Bad Schoenborn (south of Heidelberg) named after him. During World War I he was a medical officer at the west front (France) and was highly decorated (iron cross I + II, knight's cross).
