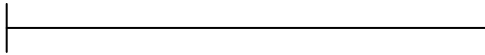


PFEIFFER + MARX FAMILY IN WEIKERSHEIM Version 01

MARX ANSCHEL

since 1761 Court Jew in Weikersheim for Prince Hohenlohe
built new synagogue in 1768



AARON MARX

Court Jew in Weikersheim
adopted father's name as family name **MARX**
1761 - 1835 died in Weikersheim
married **Jette Baruch**
1761 - 1840 died in Weikersheim

PFEIFFER MARX changed name to EZECHIEL PFEIFFER

Court Jew in Weikersheim
adopted his first name as family name **PFEIFFER**
1766 - 1827 died in Weikersheim (grasve 389)
married in 1785 **Gela (Eva) Neckarsulmer**
who died 1824 in Weikersheim

HIRSCH MARX born in Weikersheim
1800 - 1876 died in Ulm
moved from Weikersheim to Mergentheim
finally in 1864 to Ulm, where he died
married in 1827 **Sophie Lehmann**
1798 - 1863 died in Mergentheim

MARX PFEIFFER
banker since 1806 in Stuttgart
1786 - 1842 died in Stuttgart
married (1) in 1808 **Henriette Kaulla**
who died 1812 in Stuttgart
married (2) in 1817 **Dorothea Kaulla**
1801-1822 died in Stuttgart
married (3) in 1823 **Pauline Wittersheim**
1801 - 1867 died in Stuttgart

LEOPOLD MARX - born Schmajer Loeb
since 1857 factory owner in Ulm
1829 Weikersheim - 1909 Ulm
married (1) 1857 in Jebenhausen
Henriette Gutmann from Jebenhausen
1837 - 1858 died in Weikersheim
married (2) 1860 in Buchau
Louise Einstein from Buchau
1838 - 1862 died in Ulm
married (3) 1863 in Ulm
Clementine Einstein from Buchau
1842 - 1930 died in Ulm

EDUARD PFEIFFER
1835 - 1921 buried at Prag Cemetery in Stuttgart
cofounder of Wuerttembergische Vereinsbank in Stuttgart
promoted famous housing project for working class families
became 1906 citizen of honour in Stuttgart
married in 1872 **Julie Benary** (nee Kahn) from Frankfurt/Main
widow of Berlin born banker Benary in Paris
1843 - 1926 died in Stuttgart
