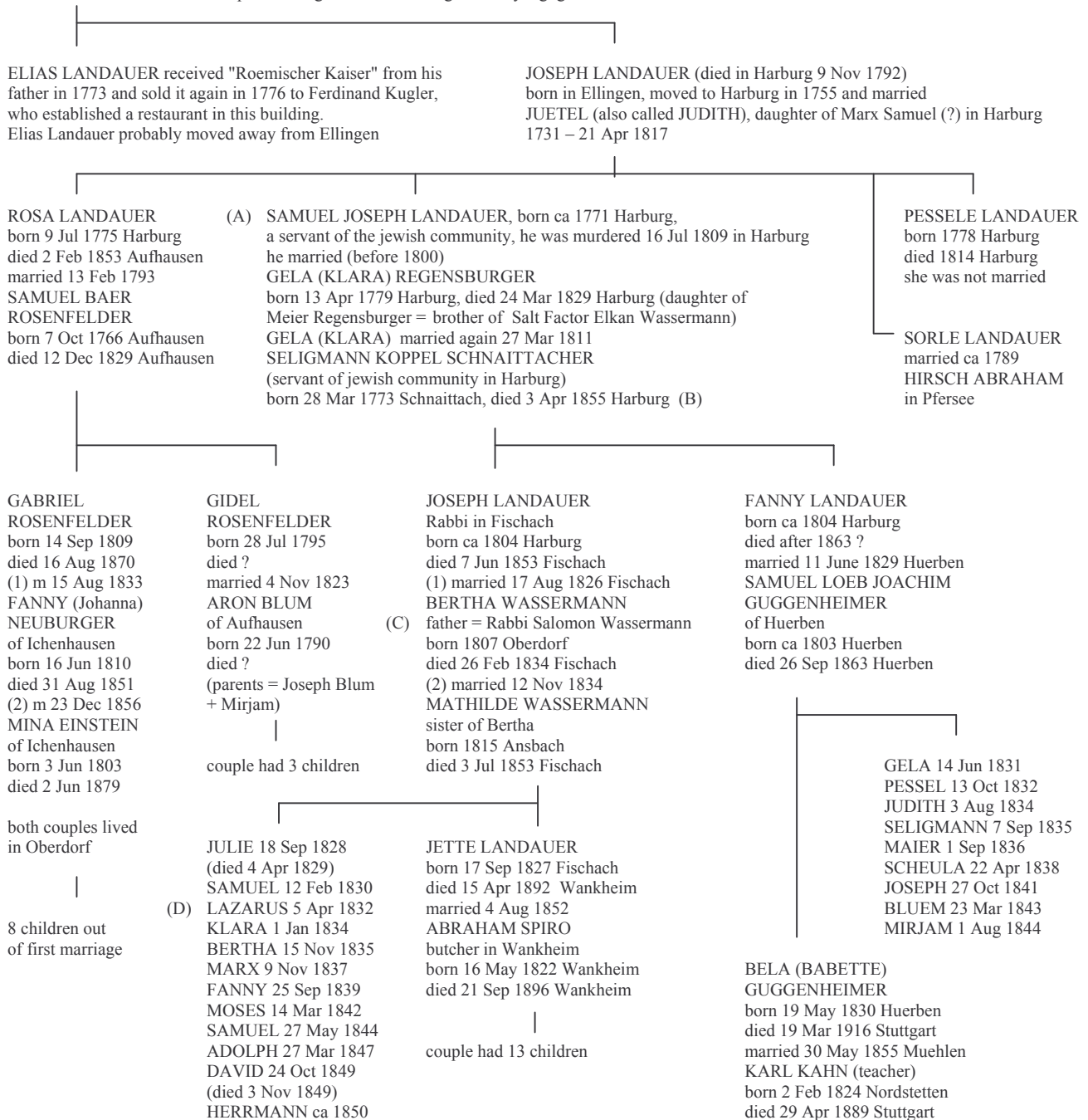


LANDAUER FAMILY OF ELLINGEN-HARBURG-FISCHACH

SAMUEL LANDAUER bought the building called "Roemischer Kaiser" (Roman Emperor) in Ellingen in 1741 from Loew Amson and donated part of the ground for building a new Synagogue 1757 - 1759



(A) The killer of Samuel Joseph Landauer (a christian citizen of a nearby village) was decapitated in 1809 (last execution in Harburg)
 (B) SELIGMANN SCHNAITTACHER married again 12 Aug 1829 in Harburg JETTE GÜGGENHEIMER of Huerben (born 14 Jan 1809, died after 1855 where ?), daughter of Hajum Guggenheimer.
 (C) SALOMON WASSERMANN was born in June 1780 in Oberdorf as son of teacher Joseph, first he became Rabbi in Laupheim, since 1835 Rabbi in Mergentheim – his son MOSES WASSERMANN became Rabbi in Muehringen, later in Stuttgart.
 (D) LAZARUS LANDAUER later called himself LOUIS LANDAUER and married MINA KAUFMANN (born 22 Nov 1834 Hochberg), he had a gold and silver business in Stuttgart and died there 30 Sep 1912 – his wife died 3 Jan 1900 (both buried at Prag Cemetery Stuttgart)
