

The Study Programme "ACCESS-Europe" *

"ACCESS-Europe" is a certificate course additional to, but integrated into, the students own course. It consists of bi- and multilateral activities that have been tried and tested, other training and educative opportunities already available in the students course and further programmes which are specificially designed for the certificate. With the certificate "ACCESS-Europe" an additional qualification for European (international/intercultural) youth-, community- and social work is attested.

"ACCESS-Europe" is designed as a modular training scheme. Students who have successfully completed all modules receive this certificate.

The Modules of "ACCESS-Europe"

Module 1: Studies - at home and/or abroad

Language tuition

2 terms/semesters (2 hours/week)

Module 2: Studies - at home and/or abroad

European Community Studies 2 terms/semesters (2 hours/week)
