

Rules for your visit to Eltz Castle



Dear visitors,

Eltz Castle – an important historical witness – is situated in the midst of an area of unspoilt nature. In order to make this natural paradise and monument accessible to everyone and to preserve it for future generations, you are required to adhere to the following rules when visiting the castle:

- ❖ Please respect the tranquillity of the nature and avoid excessive noise in order not to disturb others.
- ❖ Leave all vehicles and bicycles at the car park.
- ❖ Access to the Eltz Forest and the castle complex is entirely at your own risk.
- ❖ Please be aware that surfaces can be slippery when it rains.
- ❖ Do not enter any fenced off areas or climb on rocks and walls.
- ❖ Do not remove any stones and leave them where they are.
- ❖ Please keep the forest and castle area tidy and take all your litter home.
- ❖ Camping and open fires are prohibited by law.
- ❖ Flying drones is prohibited on the entire estate, including the Eltz Forest and the castle complex.
- ❖ Photographs taken of the castle may only be used for private purposes.
- ❖ Not adhering to these rules may lead to you being asked to leave the premises.
