## **GUSTAV ERLEBACHER** (A)

teacher in Goldbach near Aschaffenburg, since August 1922 in Moenchsroth  
lived there with wife Rika + sons Hermann + Arthur  
born 2 Jan 1878 Diedelsheim/Baden, died 25 Nov 1941 Kaunas  
victim of the Shoah  
parents = Salomon Erlebacher + wife Babette nee Kahn (B)

married 28 Feb 1909 in Lehrberg near Ansbach (Franconia)

## **FRIEDRIKE WILD** (called Rika)

born 23 Nov 1877 or 1878 ? Wallerstein, died 15 Feb 1936 Moenchsroth  
she was buried at Wallerstein Jewish cemetery grave 990  
parents = butcher Isak Wild + wife Hanna nee Mayer in Wallerstein (C)

(A) Gustav Erlebacher spent his youth in Baisingen, where his family had moved from Diedelsheim. He was trained as a teacher and served in Goldbach (Franconia) and Moenchsroth (near Dinkelsbuehl in Franconia). Around 1935 he completed the grave list of the Jewish cemetery of Wallerstein, a list that once was compiled by the teacher Hieronymus Stein around 1890. After Gustav Erlebacher's wife had died in Moenchsroth and was buried at the Wallerstein Jewish cemetery, he first moved to Oettingen (November - December 1937) and then to Munich and finally lived in a home for old Jewish people at Klenze Strasse nr 4, from where he was deported on 20 Nov 1941 to Kaunas, where he lost his life at unknown circumstances as a victim of the Shoah.
