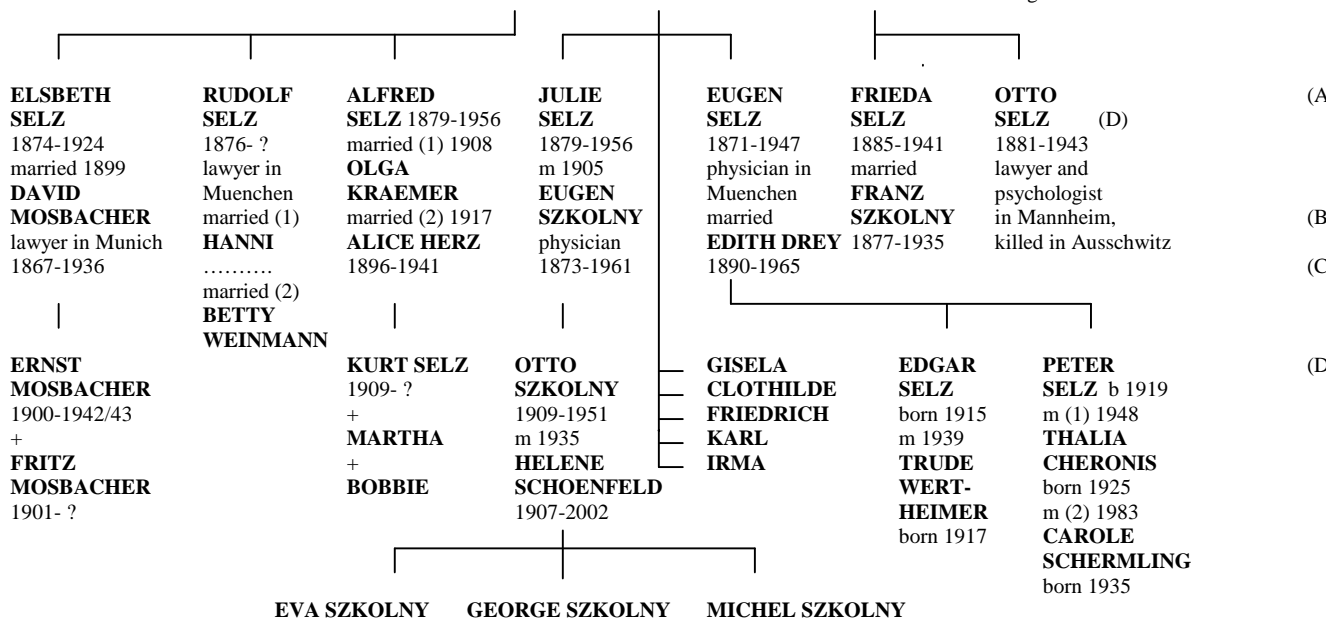
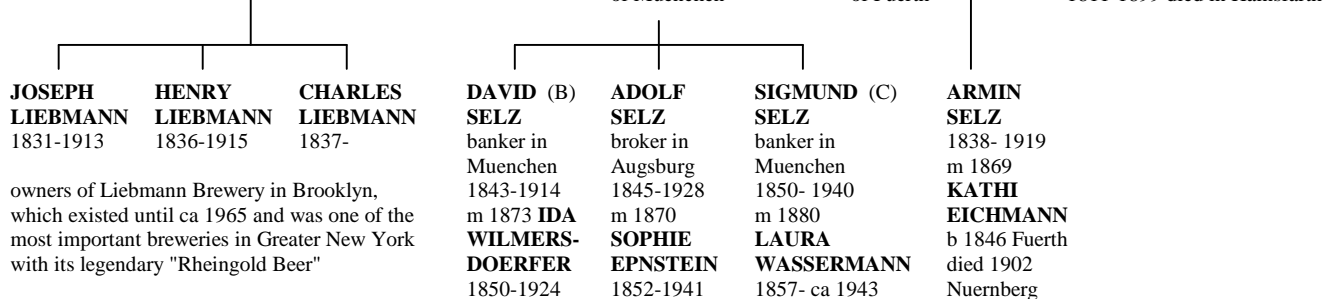
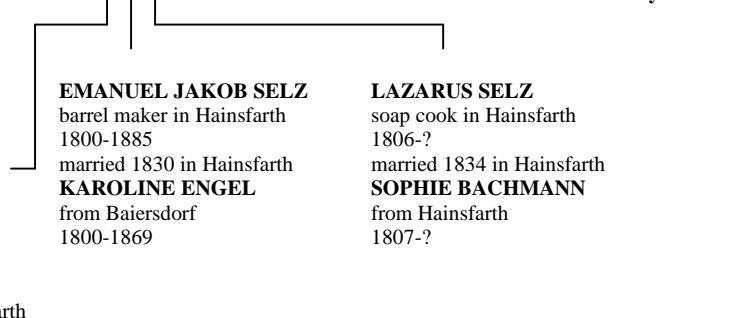

ABRAHAM JAKOB LEVI 1754-1811 (Sulzbuerg-Harburg) servant of Saltfactor Elkan Wassermann - married 1789 in Harburg
GELA WASSERMANN 1762–1850, daughter of David Wassermann in Harburg, sister of Elkan Wassermann in Harburg



(A) **JAKOB HAYUM** from Sulzbuerg, settled 1793 in Hainsfarth (died ca 1808)
 married ca 1793 **RIFKA** = daughter of Lazarus Mannele = **Herrmann family** in 1813



Family name "Selz" was only adopted around 1813

- (A) **Jakob Hayum's widow (= Rifka Selz)** married in Hainsfarth on 29 Jan 1811 **Simon Marx Buchauer**, who had settled in Hainsfarth in 1811 and already died on 30 Dec 1821 in Hainsfarth. Rifka then must have lived with her son Lazarus Selz and left Hainsfarth together with his family around 1838.
- (B) **David Selz** was director of Bayerische Vereinsbank in Munich
- (C) **Sigmund Selz** had a joint banking business with Simon Fraenkel at Promenade Platz 5 in Munich since 1880, taken over in 1915 by Bayerische Hypothen- und Wechselbank
- (D) **Otto-Selz-Institute** at Mannheim University today reminds of **Otto Selz**
