SIEGFRIED WIESENGRUND

coal and wine trader in Noerdlingen since 1914 (Gerbergasse C 34)
together with father-in-law David Heimann
moved to Hochheim-am-Main in 1936, to Frankfurt-am-Main in 1937
born 28 Dec 1882 Dettelbach, died ? deported - victim of Shoah
parents = Adolph Wiesengrund + wife Ida nee Thalheimer

married (1) 6 Oct 1912 in New York (couple got divorced in 1936)

JULIA HEIMANN

born 6 Jan 1885 Noerdlingen, died 06 Jul 1967 New York
emigrated to New York in 1934 and married on 16 Feb 1936 **HENRY STEINER (A)**
parents = coal dealer David Heimann + wife Johanna nee Heumann

married (2) 29 Jul 1936 in Hochheim-am-Main

GERTRUD COHEN

born 30 Apr 1895 Hochheim-am-Main, died ? deported ? - victim of Shoah ?
parents = Abraham Cohen + wife Bertha nee Weis

CHILDREN (all born in Noerdlingen):

- (01) **IRENE** 25 Jul 1914 - 13 Oct 1914
- (02) **AL STEINER** 16 Aug 1915 - 15 Dec 1995
(born Adolf Wiesengrund) died in Delray Beach, Palm Beach, Florida USA
emigrated to USA in 1934, lived in New York,
adopted stepfather's family name, owner of Kinzee
Industries, manufacturer of kitchens and baths
married before 1960
LUCILLE GLOBUS from New York
born 08 Jun 1923
living in Delray Beach, Florida by 2009
parents = Aaron Globus from Russia + wife Rose
couple produced three children
- (03) **GERTRUDE** 12 Oct 1917 - 27 Jun 1986 (died in New York)
(born Gertraud) emigrated to the USA in 1934 together with Adolf
married (1) 06 Jan 1940 in New York
JOHN DESSAUER from Offenbach-am-Main
(born Hans Stefan Dessauer) since 1936 in USA
04 Feb 1913 - 09 Jan 1972
(died in De Kalb County, Georgia)
parents = ?
married (2) before 1958
HERBERT LINTON from ?
18 Oct 1908 - 25 Mar 1966 (died in New York)
buried at Riverside Cemetery, Saddle Brook NJ
parents = ?
couple produced two children

(A) **Henry Steiner** was born on 24 Aug 1868 in Alt-Sedlich (then part of Austrian Empire, after World War I Czechoslovakia) as son of cigar manufacturer **Ignatz Steiner** who had emigrated to New York in 1886 together with his family. **Henry Steiner** became a butcher in New York and married in 1893 **Emma Kahn**, who died in October 1934. **Henry Steiner** was naturalized in 1892. He died in New York on 19 Oct 1938 and was buried at Riverside Cemetery at Saddle Brook, Bergen County, New Jersey (same cemetery as his second wife **Julie nee Heimann**, who died on 06 Jul 1967 in New York). Henry Steiner + first wife Emma produced no children.

Siegfried Wiesengrund was related to the philosopher **Theodor Ludwig W Adorno** (11 Sep 1903 - 06 Aug 1969), "W" standing for Wiesengrund. His father **Oscar Alexander Wiesengrund** 1870-1946 (wholesale wine trader in Frankfurt/Main), who married **Maria Cavelli-Adorno della Plana**, was born Catholic - Oscar + Maria converted to Lutheran faith.

Oscar Alexander Wiesengrund's parents were **Theodor + Lina Wiesengrund**

A brother of Siegfried Wiesengrund was **Manfred Wiesengrund**, pharmacist in Munich (10 Aug 1879 Dettelbach - 24 Aug 1863 Munich). In 1935 he founded a pharmacy at Mount Carmel (Israel) and returned to Munich after WW II. He married (1) on 5 Dec 1910 in Ansbach **Paula nee Weil** (29 Apr 1890 Ansbach - 03 Apr 1942 Piaski - victim of Shoah), daughter of Jakob + Luise Weil. Manfred Wiesengrund married (2) on 19 Oct 1926 in Munich **Mina nee Schweisheimer** (11 Jan 1901 Noerdlingen - 16 Feb 1978 Munich), daughter of Moritz + Mathilde Schweisheimer. Child from first marriage = **Adolf** (17 Jan 1912 - 23 Dec 1912)

Children of **Salomon Wiesengrund** (who died 1921 in Nuernberg):

Elsa Wiesengrund (born 12 Nov 1878 in Dettelbach) was deported in 1942 from Nuernberg to Izbica and died there (exact date unknown).

Sophie Wiesengrund (born 3 Jan 1893 in Dettelbach) was deported in 1940 from Nuernberg to Alkhoven (NS killing institution at Hartheim castle) near Linz in Austria. She died there on 20 Sep 1940.

Elsa and Sophie were cousins of Siegfried Wiesengrund.
