

<sup>(</sup>A) Sofie's first husband was Chasan Emanuel Weiler of Dennenlohe, who died in Fischach in 1853. His son Abraham Weiler became the first Cantor of the once more founded Jewish Community of Noerdlingen in 1870 (after 363 years of absence).

<sup>(</sup>B) Rachel Weiskopf died as Mrs Rachel SHAPIRO.

<sup>(</sup>C) Jonas Weiskopf became a citizen of Noerdlingen as a baker per 1 Apr 1886 and went to Nuernberg around 1903.

<sup>(</sup>D) Max Weisskopf was born in Noerdlingen on 30 Sep 1887, when his father had his bakery at house nr C 15 Am Loewenberg.

<sup>(</sup>E) Gitella Weisskopf was born 20 Sep 1875 (where ?), probably married a Mr Meyer in Frankfurt and died 16 Mar 1943 in Theresienststadt
